



**Mobile Dental Clinic Information/Permission Slip**

The Dental Foundation of Oregon (DFO) whose mission is to improve oral health for Oregon's children will be visiting our school with their mobile dental van the Tooth Taxi the week of : **February 6 - February 10**

The van will park at a school location, children will be screened on Monday and then appointments will be made for their treatment Tuesday – Thursday/Friday.

The Tooth Taxi visits schools that have a high percentage of students that qualify for the free & reduced lunch program. The staff and volunteers of the Tooth Taxi will treat school age children K-12 giving treatment priority to children that have no dental insurance, children that have never been to the dentist, or children with an emergent need. The Tooth Taxi occasionally accepts Oregon Health Plan (OHP) dental insurance; you must provide a copy of your child's insurance card.

**Eligible students will need to complete paperwork before any screening or treatment can begin. Once the school has this permission slip you will receive paperwork packets for each child. The packets must be returned to the school 2 weeks prior to the scheduled Tooth Taxi visit.**
